Maths

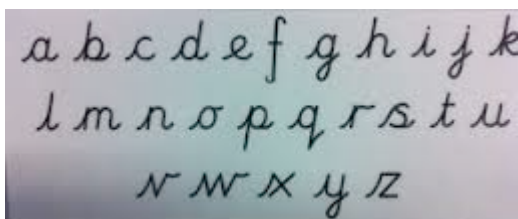
This half term we will focus on shape, time, weight and capacity alongside addition and subtraction.
