### Parent consultation

The Early Years Foundation Stage framework requires that parents and carers are supplied with a short written summary of their child's development in the three prime learning and development areas of Personal, Social and Emotional Development; Physical Development; and Communication and Language. ### Name Labels

It is really important that you label your child's clothing. Please put your child's name in their trousers, jumpers, coats and skirts. Labelled clothes will help avoid any items getting mixed up with another child's. It is essential that you provide nappies/wipes and at least one change of clothes in your child's school bag.

### Autumn Weather

Even though it will be getting cooler now, we will be going outside. The children need to wear appropriate clothes for the weather conditions. If you would like to bring your own wellies please make sure they are named and in a bag (which can hang on your child's peg).

### Please Remember



Remember to sign your child out at the end of the session, on their daily sheet. If someone different will be collecting your child, please let us know their name because people who are not known to us are not able to collect children from Acorns. In addition to this, children under the age of 16 will not be allowed to collect children. It is a busy time at the end of the session, so for the safety of our children please wait patiently while we call your child's name individually.
